Topic: Drink from the Well of Jesus

Text: John 4:7-42

Introduction: Praise the Lord for a wonderful day like today. My joy is full to see all of you that are here today. My prayer is that we will all drink from the well of Jesus and be satisfied in Jesus name. Amen

As we look into the life of the Sychar woman, we should also look at our life with the same mirror. Most often, we see ourselves as superior; “Holier than thou” and with a “we are not like them” attitude. This could be because of differences in skin color, race or educational status. One thing is certain, Christ came to the world to die for EVERYONE. Are you an Israelite, Samaritan, American, Asian, African? Are you from the East, West, North or South region of the world? Are you black, brown, yellow or white? Regardless of where you’re from or who you are, know that Jesus Christ has paid the price for your redemption and He is your Savior.

As we go through the text (John 4: 7), we see that Jesus was the first to ask for a drink from this woman. Jesus asked for physical water, verse 7; “There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water. Jesus saith unto her, GIVE ME TO DRINK”. Later in the chapter, we read that this woman now asked Jesus to give her water. This time, she was asking for both physical and spiritual water, verse 15; “The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw” Something happened in between the two conversation:

- Jesus preached life into her.
- The woman listened and accepted.
- The eyes of this Sychar woman began to open.
- Jesus Christ revealed himself to her vs 26, “Jesus saith unto her, ‘I that speak unto thee am he.’”

Has Jesus revealed himself to you yet?

After this woman received the revelation, she left her water pot at the well!

Someone who went to the well to get an essential item (water) probably for herself and her family now left the well without water! Hmm... is that not crazy?

See how the power of the word was so heavy and charming on her that she left her water pot behind to tell others about Jesus. She became a radical for Jesus and she didn’t care about her pressing need, “the water”, at that moment any more.

My fellow ladies, you also need to hear such words. Words that will be so heavy and charming on you that you too will become a radical for Jesus, like the Sychar woman.

Have you heard such word that made you change your priority before? Do you need to hear such word repeatedly in order to be consistent in your service to Jesus? That Sychar woman became a preacher, a prophetess and also a lady evangelist, verse 29, “come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did...” Before long, she had followers and even a congregation! My prayer is that God will make you a powerful woman, a powerful Christian, and a child of the most High, who leads people/sinners to God and to His kingdom. Amen

In conclusion, let's see verse 40-42, “So when the Samaritans were come unto him...and said unto the woman, now we believe...and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world.”

Like the people of Sychar, you need to hear Jesus personally and not only rely on what others say about Him. Have a daily encounter with him so that your spirit will be renewed in Jesus Mighty Name.

Prayer: Father God, we thank you for times like this in our lives. We give you the praise and honor. As you revealed yourself to the Sychar woman, we pray oh Lord, that you reveal yourself to us in the same way in Jesus Mighty Name. Amen

As you revealed yourself to the Sychar people, we pray for all those who attended this conference, that you will reveal yourself to them.

Together as one, we want to give you a drink by submitting and surrendering our lives to you totally with no reservations to ourselves. We want to drink from your everlasting well in Jesus Christ Mighty Name. Amen

After hearing the words of life, Father we pray that you will save us, change us, and turn our lives around as you did in the life of this Sychar woman in Jesus Mighty Name. Amen

Help us to always be focused and think of heaven in all that we do and say.

Every form of distraction from you, from your word and from your work, we pray that you will destroy them from our lives in Jesus Mighty Name. Amen
