Opening Declaration

Introduction

This message is titled Put Off and Put On. Christianity is not only about what we stop doing, but also about what we intentionally begin to live out.

Part 1: What to Put Off

According to Colossians 3:8-9, believers must put off anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language, lying, and the old sinful nature. Putting off without putting on creates a spiritual gap that leaves believers vulnerable. Jesus warns in Matthew 12:43-45 and Luke 11:24-26 that when evil leaves and finds the house empty, it returns stronger. Deliverance without replacement leads to relapse.

Self-Examination

Are there attitudes or habits God is asking you to release? What about your prayer life, Bible study, forgiveness, and spiritual growth? This is a call to honest reflection.

Part 2: What to Put On

As God's chosen, holy, and beloved people, we are to put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, long-suffering, patience, forgiveness, and forbearance. God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble.

Above All: Put On Love

Love is the bond of perfection. Love God, love your neighbor, and love yourself. You cannot love others properly if you do not first love yourself (Matthew 22:37-39).
